

# **Directions to East Side Locations**

**PETROLEUM CENTER BRIDGE IS CLOSED TO VEHICLES**

**But open to walking and bicycles.**

**Follow Rt 227 Detour signs for Petroleum Center Rd.**

### **From the Northwest**

Take State Route 8 south from Titusville approximately 13 miles to Rouseville and the intersection with Route 227. Follow Route 227 north to the village of Plumer. Watch for signs and take Petroleum Center Road (on the left) to the park office area at the bottom of the hill.

### **From the Northeast**

Take route 227 south from Pleasantville approximately 7  $\frac{3}{4}$  miles to the Village of Plumer. Watch for signs for Oil Creek State Park and turn right onto Petroleum Center Road. Follow that approximately 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles to the base of the hill. The park office and amphitheater will be on the right, and the Egbert picnic area will be on the left.

### **From the South**

Take route 8 north from Oil City (approximately 2 miles) to Rouseville. Take Route 227 north to the village of Plumer. Watch for signs to Oil Creek State Park. Take Petroleum Center Road (on the left) to the bottom of the hill where you will see the park office and Egbert Farm picnic area.

### **Parking:**

Parking is available in the Egbert picnic area, by the park office and by the bike trail head.

The Bike Trail that uses State Park Road can be accessed from the east side.

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### **West Side Locations**

**Blood Farm, Train Station, Wild Cat Hollow, and Group Camping  
and points north of Petroleum Center can be accessed by  
State Park Road.**
